



# Jura, Domaine Jean-Luc Mouillard, Sélection, AOC L'Etoile, Blanc, 2017

AOC L'Etoile, Jura, France

The Domaine Jean-Luc Mouillard is located in the village of Mantryn in the heart of the vineyards. Jean-Luc comes from a family of winegrowers and he has always felt this winegrowing fibre which has enabled him to develop his business over the years. 11 hectares of vines spread over three appellations: Château-Chalon, Côtes du Jura and Étoile. His estate is built on cellars dating from the 16th century, combining history and innovation.

#### **PRESENTATION**

This wine is the result of a perfect balance between a blend of grape varieties: chardonnay and savagnin. Both come from a small appellation: L'Etoile where only white and yellow wines are produced.

#### IN THE VINEYARD

Concerned about respecting the environment, this passionate winegrower is determined to use integrated farming methods in his various plots.

#### **AGEING**

Bottled after two years in casks.

### **VARIETALS**

Chardonnay 50%, Savagnin 50%

#### **SERVING**

To be drunk between 12° and 14° (54 to 58°F).

## AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long, 2 to 3 years, 5 years, 5 to 10 years

### **TASTING**

A powerful nose with aromas of green almonds and dried fruits.

## **FOOD PAIRINGS**

To be served with snails with parsley, fondues, cheese tarts, white meats. Perfect match: Potato/bacon/county pie
