



Alsace, Domaine Loew, All you need is Loew -Pinot Noir, AOC Alsace, Rouge

Domaine Loew is a family winery located next to Strasbourg. It was founded in 1996 by Etienne Loew, coming from a family with a rich history dating back to the 18th century. The estate of 6.5 hectares is spread out on 5 villages, with many various terroirs, but all the same subsoil of marl. Etienne is very attached to the protection of his land: the estate has been farmed biodynamically since 1996.

PRESENTATION

A wine full of fruit and freshness.

TERROIR

Black marl soil. Exposed East.

IN THE VINEYARD

Yield between 25 and 40 hL/ha.

WINEMAKING

Hand-harvested, indigenous yeasts only. Harvested only in fruit days, according to the Biodynamic calendar. Maceration for 11 days (95% whole clusters). Pumpin over 1 to 3 times a day. No filtration, bottled on leaf day.

VARIETAL

Pinot Noir 100%

TECHNICAL DATA Production volume: 250 cs

12,5 % VOL.

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long, 3 to 5 years

TASTING

Black cherry aromas with subtle hints of licorice and caramel, fruity and fresh.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Red meats, game, charcuterie, but also with red fruit desserts.
