Xavier Frissant is a family winery, passed on 8 generations, composed of 15 hectares located on the slopes south of the Loire River, in the village of Mosnes. The vineyard expands on 5 differents hamlets and 2 different terroirs, and on 3 appellations: it has been organic since 2021. Maintaing healthy soils is the watchword in this estate!

IN THE VINEYARD

Vines are organically certified, the grass cover is there natural.

Age of vines: 12 years

WINEMAKING

After mechanical harvesting, the bunches are destemmed then pressed using pneumatic pressing. Fermentation alcoholic lasts 30 days in stainless steel vats.

AGEING

Aging in 300L barrels for 4 months then our wines are bottled in the spring.

VARIETAL

Fié gris 100%

SERVING

12°C/54°F

AGEING POTENTIAL

2 to 3 years

TASTING

Freshness, nice fullness on the palate with a mineral finish.
