Six centuries before Christ, the Greeks made Alalia (Aleria) wine one of their favorite drinks. In 35 BC, Virgil already mentioned the qualities of Balagne wine. During the centuries of invasions and troubles that followed the fall of the Roman Empire, the vine survived waiting for the return of peace... and winemakers.

PRESENTATION

Although belonging to the Mediterranean climate, Corsica has specific climatic features due to the presence of the sea, the mountains, and its latitude. Moreover, at first sight, Corsica appears as a "mountain in the sea" with 183 km in length and 2710 meters at its highest point, resulting in a rugged topography and a vigorous relief.

TERROIR

Nature of the soil: silty-clayey

WINEMAKING

Early morning harvest before the first heat, followed by direct pressing and fermentation at low temperature to reveal all the aromatic potential.

VARIETALS

Sciaccarellu 40%, Niellucciu 40%, Grenache noir 20%

TECHNICAL DATA

Residual Sugar: < 3 g/l

SERVING

Ideal serving temperature: between 10°C and 12°C.

TASTING

Very pale pink dress. Fine nose with notes of small red fruits and maquis with a slightly iodized perfume. Very refreshing palate combining freshness and roundness.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Appetizers, salads, cold cuts, coppa pasta.
