AOC Gigondas, Vallée du Rhône, France

Domaine Font Sarade is located in the South of France, in Vacqueyras, a small Provencal village protected by the Dentelles de Montmirail, a stone's throw from the picturesque village of Gigondas. The story begins in 1936, with René Devine, who cultivates 10 hectares of vines and sells his wine in barrels to local wine merchants. His son André took over in 1983, and gave the name Font Sarade to the estate, which means "Closed Fountain" or "Dry Quarter" in Provencal. His daughter Agnès joined him in 2002, an

PRESENTATION

Les Pigières represents the main area of the parcels.

LOCATION

1,25 Hectares located on the commune of Gigondas in the Pigières and Pailleroudas districts.

TERROIR

Land of yellow marl and of yellow marl and limestone garrigue.

IN THE VINEYARD

Exposed on the western slopes of the Dentelles de Montmirail, 60-year-old vines, yield: 36hl/ha.

WINEMAKING

Manual harvest, destemmed, vatting for 25 to 30 days at low temperature low temperature. Daily pumping over. Vinification in concrete vat

AGEING

Concrete vats for 10 months.

VARIETALS

Grenache noir 60%, Mourvèdre 35%, Syrah 5%

SERVING

16°C/61°F

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long, 10 to 15 years

This intense wine has a ruby color with aromas of very ripe black fruits, slightly spicy on the finish. It is a full-bodied wine with silky tannins that will give it great finesse and suggest 3 to 8 years of cellaring.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Red meats, meats in sauce, grilled meats, cheese, charcuterie.
