TERROIR

Association of 2 terroirs, the high terraces of rolled pebbles on clayey soil and sandy-loamy arenas

WINEMAKING

Alcoholic fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks with controlled temperatures to preserve the aromas.

VARIETAL

Syrah 100%

No sulphites.

SERVING

To be enjoyed at around 16°C

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long

TASTING

Garnet dress with hints of blue. Pretty notes of small red fruits dominated by redcurrant. In the mouth, full and gourmet with a very round finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Ideal as an aperitif with Mediterranean tapas, Escalivade (grilled summer vegetables), or rosemary skewers.
