



Domaine Bernard Fleuriet, AOP Sancerre, Red

AOP Sancerre, Vallée de la Loire et Centre, France

Since 1991, the Domaine Fleuriet has developed its own vineyards on 20 ha of sloping and fallow land belonging to the Sancerre appellation. The estate is representative of the typicity and diversity of the Sancerre region and the vines are present on the three great Sancerre terroirs (flint, caillottes and white earth).

PRESENTATION

Made from Pinot Noir grapes, this wine comes only from large clay-limestone soils which give it all its fruitiness and finesse. With 50% of its production in oak barrels, it has toasted and sustained notes as well as aromas of red fruits.

TERROIR

Clay-limestone soils

IN THE VINEYARD

Sensitive to environmental concerns and a passion for quality, the Domaine no longer use weed killers on the farm and has been cultivating its vineyards organically since 2013 and labeled organic since 2016.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation and maceration for 30 days in concrete tanks.

AGEING

Ageing for 16 months (80% in old oak barrels and 20% in tank).

VARIETAL

Pinot Noir 100%

TASTING

Time in barrels brings to this wine sustained toasted notes as well as aromas of red fruits.
