PRESENTATION

Coujérou is a typical South-West wine with a melodic name that reflects the authenticity and expertise of its winemakers.

True to its terroir and the grape varieties that compose it, it is rich and fruit-driven

THE WINE

VARIETALS: Cabernet franc, Merlot, Tannat, Cabernet sauvignon, Malbec

WINEMAKING / AGEING: Traditional vinification at temperatures between 26°C and 29°C, with a short maceration of around ten days.

TASTING

A simple, approachable red wine, easy to drink and fruit-forward.

SERVING / FOOD PAIRINGS

SERVING: Serve between 16° and 18°C.

FOOD PAIRINGS: Enjoy with grilled red meats, charcuterie, or cheeses.
