



Loire, Xavier Frissant, Massale des Pierres, AOC Touraine, Rosé

AOC Touraine, Vallée de la Loire et Centre, France

Xavier Frissant is a family winery, passed on 8 generations, composed of 15 hectares located on the slopes south of the Loire River, in the village of Mosnes. The vineyard expands on 5 differents hamlets and 2 different terroirs, and on 3 appellations: it has been organic since 2021. Maintaing healthy soils is the watchword in this estate!

PRESENTATION

TERROIR

Flint clay

IN THE VINEYARD

Vines are certified organic, the grass cover is natural.

Age of vines: 12 years

WINEMAKING

After mechanical harvesting, the bunches are destemmed then pressed using pneumatic pressing. Alcoholic fermentation lasts 30 days in stainless steel vats.

AGFING

Wines are aged on fine lees in vats stainless steel until bottling in spring.

VARIETAL

Sauvignon blanc 100%

SERVING

14°C/61°F

AGEING POTENTIAL

2 to 3 years

TASTING

Beautiful freshness, floral and lemony note with a mineral finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Grilled fish, seafood platter, goat cheeses.
