Un Voyage dans les Vignes presents its Terret blanc "Il était une fois". Terret is an ancient grape variety endemic to the Languedoc region. Long disliked for its low yields and sensitivity, it is back in the spotlight for its ability to produce powerful, distinctive whites.

PRESENTATION

Primula is a Loire white that is both spontaneous and lively.

Silts on a granitic source rock of Clisson.

Its harvest is followed by slow pressing then fermentation for two to three weeks before leaving for 6 months of aging in underground vats.

VARIETAL

Sauvignon blanc 100%

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.
